BBA syllabus orientation program

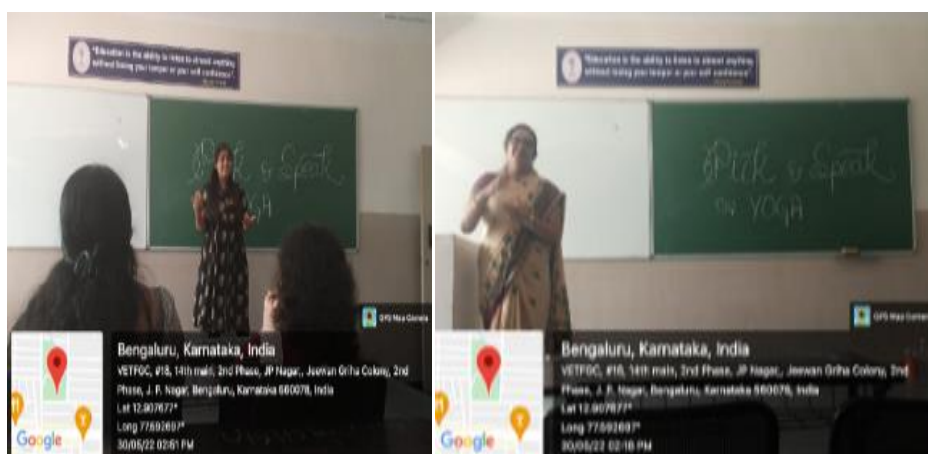

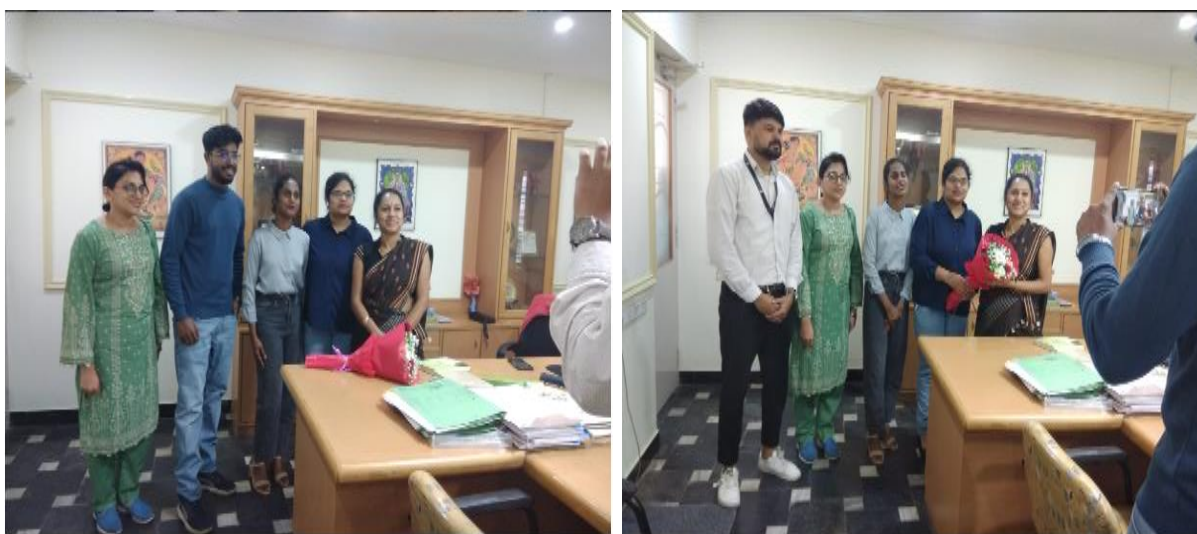
The Kalpatharu project and 75 years of Swarna Mahothsava of Azad India

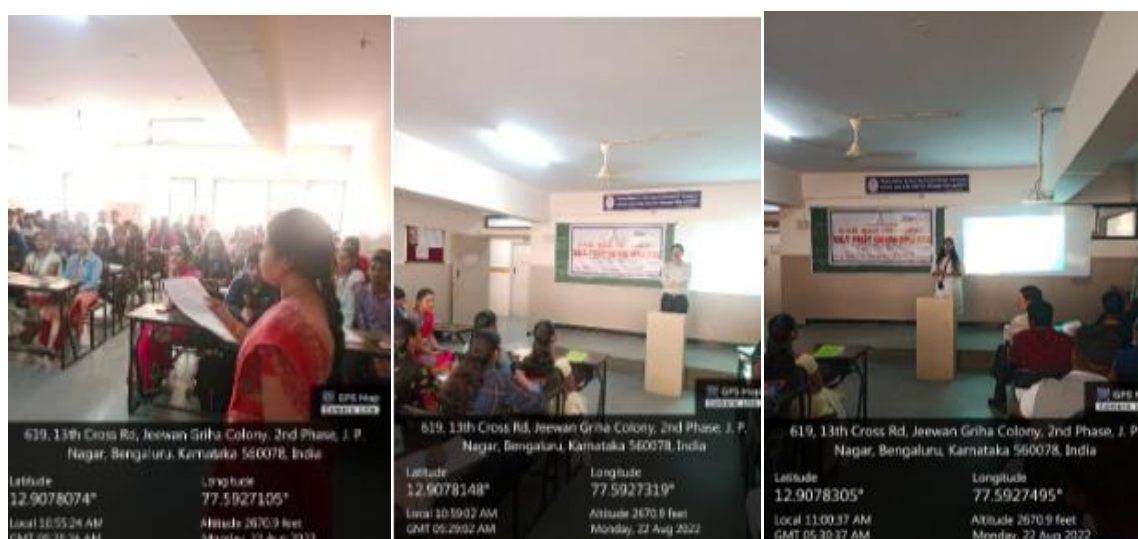


Workshop on “Neurobics”

STATE-LEVEL WORKSHOP ON COMMUNICATION SKILLS

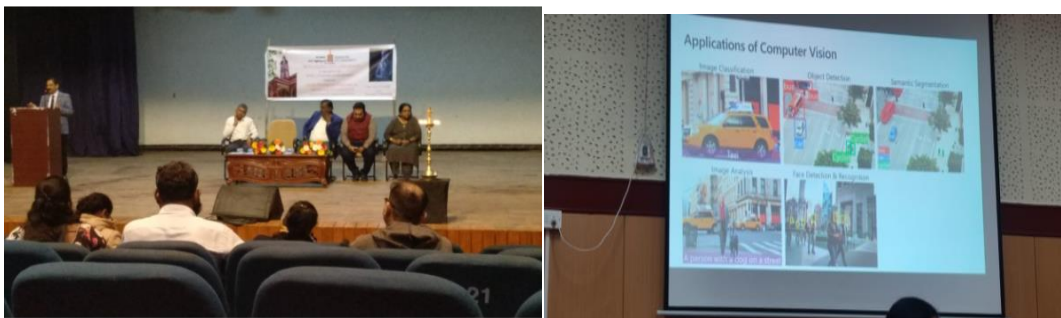

1st Place: Ananya.C.G, 2nd Place: Harshitha. M and 3rd Place: Keerthi.A.R



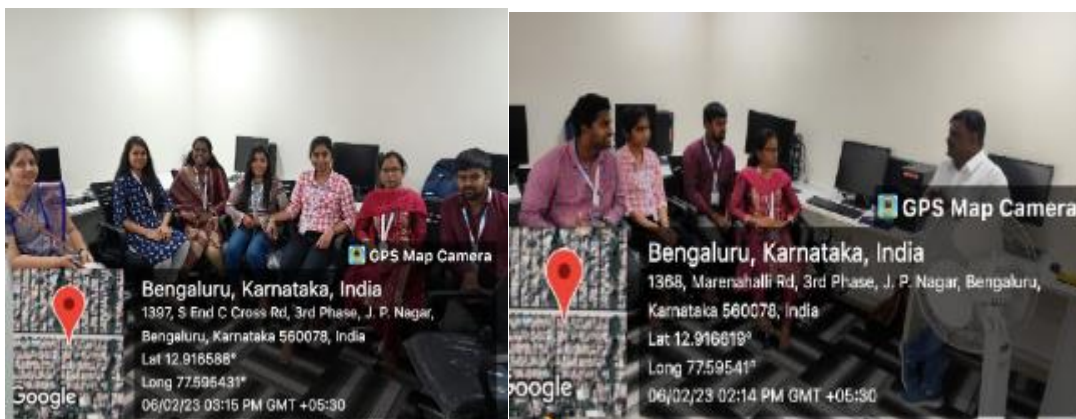
Martyr's Day

Chethana-Online Lecture series on “Holistic Education and SPICMACAY”

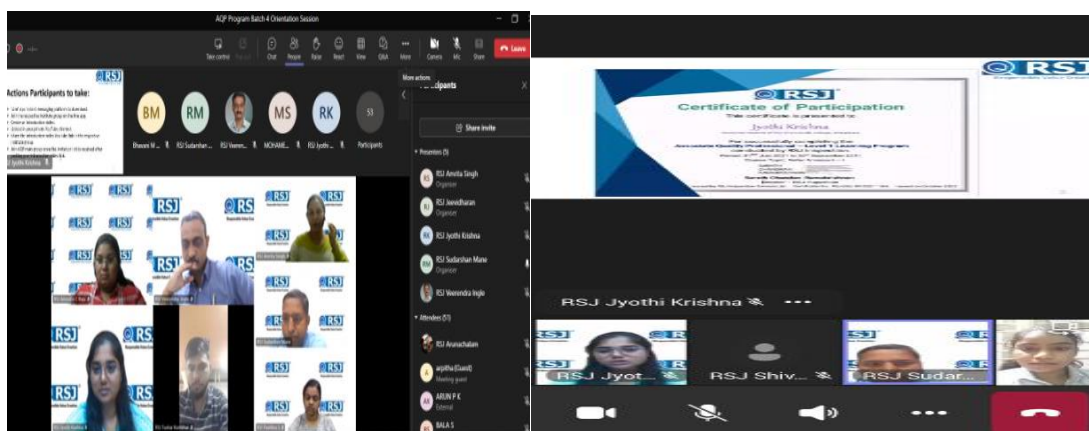

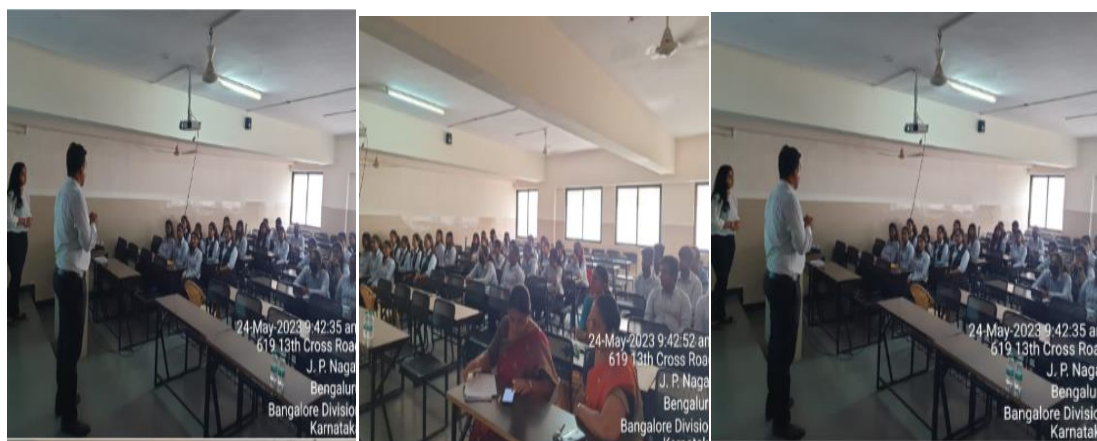
Seminar by 'Veranda Race'
