





Dr.R.Parvathi, Principal and Academic director spoke about the how important entrepreneurship to our economic development of our country eentrepreneurship is important, as it has the ability to improve standards of living and create wealth, not only for the entrepreneurs but also for related businesses, entrepreneurs also help drive change with innovation, where new and improved products enable new markets to be developed, too much entrepreneurship (i.e., high self-employment) can be detrimental to economic development

Mrs. Lokeshwari, Co-Ordinator BBA introduced the resource person for the session Punith Raj is the Founder CEO of Seminar room & EIPOC (Education and Industry Platform of Collaboration) an Edtech Start-ups which works as a liaison between Academics and Industry. At present EIPOC is offering their services to 20 different Colleges and Universities across Bangalore and targeting to reach more than 100 colleges-by mid of October 2021. Seminar room got Pre-Seed funding from PES University Venture Labs and will be going live from June 2021. In his recent tenure, he served as HOD and Mentor for Management Department at Jain University. He is in the Advisory board for Industry Interaction with the colleges like Arihant Group of Institutions, GTMT, SRSI etc. He is also a consultant to Start

Ups in Bangalore. He has got more than 12 years of Academic experience and 6 years of corporate experience working as a Market Analyst in J.P.Morgan Chase India and Cambridge Solutions, London. He is an analyst with experience in 'Futures and Options'. He has worked in England, Scotland and various places of Europe. He has several research papers to his credit and has won many best paper awards across National and International Conferences. He has given speeches in various forums and colleges. He has written popular articles in Newspaper and Magazines. He is pursuing his Ph.d., under the domain of Management at Jain University. He is interested in building young entrepreneurs for our country. State committee member, economic cell Karnataka BJP.

Mr. Punith Raj Started the session with his motivational words followed by few videos on the same. Also briefed on idea generation Ideas are the key to innovation, Without them, there isn't much to execute and because execution is the key to learning, new ideas are necessary for making any kin of improvement. It's obvious that ideas alone won't make innovation happen, as you need to be able to build a systematic process for managing those ideas. The point of ideation isn't just about generating tons of them but about paying attention to the quality of those as well. We agree that it can sometimes be difficult to come up with more of those high-quality ideas. It's not unusual to get stuck in our old habits and routines when we're supposed to be creating something new. He also showed a demo on business plan for start-ups like assumptions, salaries and also about revenue matrices.







Doctor advised to take one tablet in the night after dinner. This initiative every 6 months is taken up by Government of Karnataka, health department which is a noble cause extended towards general public.


The health committee members helped to distribute the free samples to all discipline students in their respective classes.


REPORT ON ENVIRONMENT DAY - GREEN DAY

It was indeed a pleasant break from the monotony and the subtle major impact- the feel good factor had a very favourable effect on the blooming buds' emotional well-being.




Solo performance of dance was given by Ms Pooja of 1st BBA and Mr Mallesh of 1st BCA.



हिंदी से ही हिंद है। विश्व की सबसे बड़ी भाषा हिंदी है। उन्होंने कहा कि अब हिंदी राष्ट्र भाषा की गंगा से विश्व भाषा का महासागर बन रही है। विद्यार्थियों को आधुनिकता एवं अंग्रेजीयत से अलग होकर हिन्दी की रोचकता और महता को जानने पहचानने की जरूरत है। आज हिंदी भारत में ही नहीं बल्कि विश्व भर में बोली समझी जाने वाली विश्व भाषाओं में अपनी पहचान स्थापित कर चुकी है और शब्दों की संख्या के आधार पर भी विश्व की सबसे बड़ी भाषा हिंदी बन गई है।आज विद्यार्थियों के बीच अंग्रेजी भाषा के प्रति बढ़ते लगाव और हिंदी भाषा की अनदेखी करने की वजह से हिंदी प्रेमी बेहद निराश हैं। यही वजह है कि हर साल देशभर के लोगों को अपनी राष्ट्रभाषा के प्रति जागरूक करने के लिए हिंदी दिवस मनाया जाता है। भारत में भले ही अंग्रेज़ी बोलना सम्मान की बात मानी जाती हो, पर विश्व के बहुसंख्यक देशों में अंग्रेज़ी का इतना महत्व नहीं है। हिंदी बोलने में हिचक का एकमात्र कारण पूर्व प्राथमिक शिक्षा के समय अंग्रेज़ी माध्यम का चयन किया जाना है। आज भी भारत में अधिकतर अभिभावक अपने बच्चों का दाखिला ऐसे स्कूलों में करवाना चाहते हैं, जो अंग्रेज़ी माध्यम से शिक्षा प्रदान करते हैं। जबकि मनोवैज्ञानिकों के अनुसार शिशु सर्वाधिक आसानी से अपनी मातृभाषा को ही ग्रहण कर पाता है और मातृभाषा में किसी भी बात को भली-भांति समझ सकता है। अंग्रेज़ी भारतीयों की मातृभाषा नहीं है। अतः भारत में बच्चों की शिक्षा का सर्वाधिक उपयुक्त माध्यम हिंदी ही है। सबसे बड़ी बात हिंदी भाषा जैसे लिखी जाती है, वैसे बोली भी जाती है। दूसरी भाषाओं में कई अक्षर साइलेंट होते हैं और उनके उच्चारण भी लोग अलग-अलग करते हैं, लेकिन हिंदी के साथ ऐसा नहीं होता, इसीलिए हिंदी को बहुत सरल भाषा कहा जाता है। हिंदी कोई भी बहुत आसानी से सीख सकता है। हिंदी अति उदार, समझ में आने वाली सहिष्णु भाषा होने के साथ भारत की राष्ट्रीय चेतना की संवाहिका भी है। भारत की मौजूदा शिक्षा पद्धति में बालकों

को पूर्व प्राथमिक स्कूल ही अंग्रेज़ी के गीत रटाये जाते हैं। यदि घर में बालक बिना अर्थ जाने ही आने वाले अतिथियों को अंग्रेज़ी में कविता सुना दे तो माता-पिता का मस्तक गर्व से ऊंचा हो जाता है।इस मौके पर शिक्षकों सहित सैकड़ों छात्र-छात्राएं चेतना सत्र में शामिल होकर कार्यक्रम को सफल बनाया।

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL - ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING 18.12.2021

One day workshop was organized by equal opportunity cell to create awareness amongst the students regarding human trafficking, since students are also one of the prime victims of human trafficking session was conducting to shed the lime light on.

The session began with welcome speech by the Head of the Equal Opportunity Cell Mrs. Meera Balaram Asst. professor, Commerce and Management. We formally welcomed the resource person Mrs. K. M. Rohini, Advocate in High Court Bangalore and Dr R Parvathi Principal and Academic Director and B. Rammya IQAC Co-ordinator. Since the workshop was in association with Inner wheel club, President of Inner wheel club Kalpana Brama Desham and Mrs Vani sharma member of Inner wheel club was also welcomed.

Resource person began the session by giving introduction on Human trafficking and how people will turn out to be victims of the same.

She highlighted factors influencing human trafficking like Poverty, Lack of employment opportunities, Religious/ Traditional Prostitution, Child Marriage, False promises for job/marriage, Migration, Sex tourism, Internet Pornography, Dreams of Better future.

Not only women and children but also men are subject to human trafficking. In India, a large number of people are trafficked not only for sex trade but also for other various kinds of servitude.

Human trafficking is very common in countries like Southeast Asia, eastern Europe, and sub-Saharan Africa-developing countries where recruiters seek migrants through various mediums such as the Internet, employment agencies, the media, and local contacts. Middlemen who recruit from within the origin country commonly are from the same race and cultural background of those migrating and act as agents. Human traffickers often create transnational demands for transporting migrants who are driven voluntarily by unfavourable living conditions to seek better life and future through the services of a smuggler. Migrants view the services of a smuggler as an opportunity to move from impoverished conditions in their home countries to more stable, developed environments. But it is very difficult for the victims to obtain legitimate travel documents because of their lack of knowledge, education exposure and financial constraints and they voluntarily become the pray for the smugglers and the smugglers supply migrants with fraudulent passports or visas and advise them to avoid detection by border-control agents. Although victims often leave their destination country voluntarily, the majority are unaware that they are being recruited for a trafficking scheme. Some may be kidnapped or coerced, but majority it is by voluntary by the victims who are bribed by false job opportunities, passports, or visas. Transporters involved in trafficking victims from the origin country are compensated only after they have taken migrants to the responsible party in the destination country. Immigration documents, whether legitimate or fraudulent, are seized by the traffickers when once they enter the destination country and after this, victims are often

subjected to physical and sexual abuse, and many are forced into labour or the sex trade in a very inhuman, un-hygienic conditions in order to pay off their migratory debts.

The cause of human trafficking stems from adverse circumstances in origin countries, including religious persecution, political dissension, lack of employment opportunities, poverty, wars, and natural disasters. Another causal factor is globalization, which has catapulted developing countries into the world's market, increasing the standard of living and contributing to the overall growth of the global economy. Unfortunately, globalization is a double-edged sword in that it has shaped the world's market for the transportation of illegal migrants, affording criminal organizations the ability to expand their networks and create transnational routes that facilitate the transporting of migrants. The most prevalent form of human trafficking that results in servitude is the recruitment and transport of people into the international sex industry. Sex slavery involves males and females, both adults and children, and constitutes an major percentage in all trafficking activities. It consists of different types of servitude, including forced prostitution, pornography, and sex-related occupations such as nude dancing and modelling. Forced prostitution is a very old form of enslavement, and recruitment into this lifestyle is often a booming business. Victims of sexual slavery are often manipulated into believing that they are being relocated to work in legitimate forms of employment. Those who enter the sex industry as prostitutes are exposed to inhumane and potentially fatal conditions, and infectious terminal disease and shunted by the Society. Additionally, some countries, including India, Nepal, and Ghana, and other developing and third world countries have a form of human trafficking known as ritual (religion-based) slavery, in which young girls are provided as sexual slaves to atone for the sins of family members. Young girls are also used as sex workers in Spa and Massage Parlours, the hidden form of Prostitution.

Forced labour as likely been around since shortly after the dawn of humankind, though there are a number of different forms of modern involuntary servitude that can go easily unnoticed by the general public. Debt bondage, is the enslavement of people for unpaid debts and is one of the most common forms of contemporary forced labour. Similarly, contract slavery uses false or deceptive contracts to justify or explain forced slavery.

Children are often sold or sent to areas with the promise of a better life but instead encounter various forms of exploitation. Domestic servitude places "extra children" (children from excessively large families) into domestic service, often for extended periods of time. Other trafficked children are often forced to work in small-scale cottage industries, manufacturing operations, and the entertainment and sex industry. They are frequently required to work for excessive periods of time, under extremely hazardous working conditions, and for little or no wages. They are also used for prostitution, theft, begging, or the drug trade.

At the end session was made interactive and students were given an opportunity to clear their doubts, amongst them one student came out with the question as on how students can be victims of human trafficking. The resource person in turn gave the answer by stating drug peddling would be the major source for being victim.

The session ended by vote of thanks by Mrs.Febina K S Asst professor BCA Department.










Report on 75th independence day



VET First Grade College, Jointly organized with JP Nagar Citizens & Cultural Association (JPNCCA), in collaboration with Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) conducted an Extension Activity on Litter clearance and prevention drive – Ward 178 for NSS Students of VET First Grade college on Saturday 11-Jun-2022 at 9:30am.

The drive is to create awareness on waste management. Bangalore city generates around 4500MT/day of municipal solid waste (MSW) at an average of 0.5 kg/day/per capita, with about 8.4 million people. Less than 60% of waste is collected; approximately 15% of waste is processed finally dumped into landfills. A waste management system is the strategy an organization uses to dispose, reduce, reuse, and prevent waste. Possible waste disposal methods are recycling, composting, incineration, landfills, bioremediation, waste to energy, and waste minimization.

The session started with the welcome address by Dr. GS Rajanna, Member, JPNCCA.

The dignitaries are Dr. R. Parvathi, Academic Director & Principal, VET First Grade College, Mr. B.R. Viswanath Setty, President, Vasavi educational Trust, Ms. Sowmya Reddy Hon' MLA, Jayanagar Constituency, Dr. Komala, Nodal Officer, Ms. Shashikala AEE-SWD, BBMP, Mr. K R Kumar JPNCC President, Mr. Prahlad Rao JPNCC Secretary.

"WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A MALE? NEUROSCIENCE OF MASCULINITY - 29.01.2022"

Neuroscience is the study of the nervous system from a scientific standpoint to study the basic and emergent features of neurons, glia, and neural circuits, it is a multidisciplinary discipline that incorporates physiology, anatomy, molecular biology, developmental biology, cytology, computer science, and mathematical modelling.

Masculinity is defined as a man's societal expectations: In a particular civilization, the term 'masculinity' refers to the roles, behaviours, and characteristics that are deemed suitable for boys and men. Masculinity is socially, historically, and politically produced rather than biologically determined.

Being honest with oneself about one's own feelings, wants, and desires is a sign of healthy masculinity. It also entails treating everyone with the respect and kindness that you deserve. It is not healthy masculinity to use your size, strength, or power

to acquire what you want from others. A man who is authentically manly accepts responsibility and values his family and loved ones by loving, honouring, protecting, and providing for them. He leads a life of integrity, driven by conviction rather than comfort or convenience. True masculinity is measured by the strength of a man's character rather than his physical power.

I Q A Cell, V E T First Grade College organized on 29.01.2022 ONE DAY WORKSHOP in association with Inner wheel club of Bangalore, J.P. Nagar with title "What it means to be a Male? Neuroscience of Masculinity" at 10.30 am. The One Day Workshop began with welcome speech by Ms. Rammya. B, Coordinator IQAC, and Dr. B. N. Sathya Bhama, Placement Officer, VET First Grade College who introduced the **Dr. Mayur Vijaykumar Kaku**, resource speaker of the day followed by Dr. R. Parvathi, Academic Director & Principal's speech.

practises yoga, usually called 'Yogic Neurosurgeon'. He is a complex brain and spine surgeon at Bangalore's HCG Hospital. He has a Neurosurgery certification from Bangalore's National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (NIMHANS). attributes through chat box. He then explained basic attributed required by a male to live normal life.



Few to mention attributes of masculine are differentiating, think individual, external focused, part focused, results oriented, competitive, hierarchical structure, action, doing, focus on intent, logic, independent, urgent, analysis, think through head, speaking, directing, assertive, project, conscious, structured, linear, follow cause and effect, linear analysis, bottom line oriented and others are commonly seen.

He asked the students to identify a picture of film actor from Hollywood with women, where he was actually looked very intimately standing with women but he kept his distance. He also gave a few instances of excellent masculinity from the Ramayana where we had Rama indicating good deeded one and Ravana indicating wrong deeded one, by asking students to identify the situation in the picture where Ravana kidnapping Sita in the flying chariot, when Jatayu try to stop the kidnaping to the present-day Keanu Reeves, who is always respect women in his actions.


He talked on how men need to have integrity, dignity, and the ability to have true intimacy, as well as dos and don'ts to follow in their everyday lives, and how they might use emotional literacy to discover the zones of regulation. 
He explained *emotional literacy* in identifying the *ZONES of REGULATION*, such as *BLUE ZONE* indicating sad, tired, sick, moving slowly, *GREEN ZONE* indicates happy, calm, feeling OK, focused, ready to learn, *YELLOW ZONE* indicates frustrated, worried, silly or wiggly, excited, loss of some control and *RED ZONE* indicated that mad or angry, terrified yelling or hitting elated, out of control were the common zones where the individual (either male or female) is in the daily life.





The program started at 10.00 am with the introductory note by anchor/host Smt. Rammya.B, Assistant Professor and IQAC Coordinator, VET First Grade College who invited students to seek almighty's blessings for the success of the program.

Following the invocation dignitaries were welcomed by Dr.Sreelatha, Director and Principal, VET Polytechnic College. The dignitaries included Dr.Jaganath Rao Motivational speaker and Trainer, Sri.Jagadeeshwar Rao MD- Tapasya Learning, Chandrasekhar raju- Ex Corporator BBMP Ward 177- organizing secretary Kavacha foundation, Dr.Parvathi Director and Principal VET First Grade College, Smt.Roopashree, Principal VET Manandi Composite PU college and all the teachers, students present.

Then he highlighted to students the toppers strategy for scoring more. He told the students to sit in a place with upright position and study with concentration for 45 minutes and then move a bit and recollect the key points for 15 minutes and repeat the same for the entire course of study. While recollecting if the student could not recollect few points, he asked them to immediately refer the same. This strategy of study is called the pendulum strategy. He told the students to write down the percentage what they expect to score and work towards the same. He told them to

read silently with lip movement rather than reading out aloud as per the research conducted and results established with an exception for difficult chapter which needs to be read out loudly. He made the students write down key points and also made the session very interactive and interesting. The session concluded with Speaker addressing the queries of the students in general and shared contact details for further communication.

Participation certificates were distributed to all the attendees by the dignitaries.



Ever since then, September 5 is celebrated as Teacher's Day across schools, colleges, universities and educational institutions.



REPORT ON "A TWO-DAY VACCINATION DRIVE"




