ABOUT B.Sc-FAD

B.Sc-Fashion and Apparel Design, also known as B.Sc-FAD is a three year Undergraduate degree programme divided into six semesters that covers various aspects of fashion, design, and textiles such as Garment Detailing, Fundamentals of Fashion Design, Textile Science, Textile Testing, Wet Processing, Surface Ornamentation, Export Trade and Documentation, Visual Merchandising, Fashion Marketing and Merchandising, Fashion Business Management, Portfolio Presentation etc.

B.Sc –FAD was introduced under the banner of VET First Grade College in the year 2004. The purpose of this course is to tell how the fashion works from Concept to Consumer.

A candidate seeking admission to first year B.Sc degree in Fashion and Apparel Design shall have passed the Pre University examination of Pre - University Board of Karnataka or any other equivalent examination. The candidate with three years diploma in Apparel Design and Fabrication Technology/ Fashion Technology / Fashion Design/ Costume Design and Dress Making/ Costume and Fashion Design are considered as equivalent and recognized by the state or Central Government are eligible for admission directly to third semester of B.Sc-FAD course.

Fashion design graduates have the opportunity to work in various fields within the fashion industry, according to their area of specialization and interest or can choose to pursue a post graduate degree in Fashion Design such as M.Sc-Textiles & Clothing, M.Sc-Apparel Technology & Management and M.Sc Fashion Design.

The fashion design team at VET includes experienced, efficient, dedicated and outstanding faculty who support and promote excellence by focusing on student achievements, quality teaching and the right balance of curricular and extra- curricular activities. The faculty with its quality teaching both in theoretical and practical aspects is focused on developing creativity and skills of the students, to prepare them for different portals of fashion industry.

Faculty, as mentors are encouraging the students to excel in their areas of interest and develop their knowledge through their field trips, industrial visits, educational tours etc.


BRIDGE COURSE

The silk weaving factory which was handed over to Karnataka Silk Industry Corporation Ltd, a Government of Karnataka Enterprise in 1980 is popularly known as KSIC. It is the only organization in the country producing silk right from reeling of cocoons to the weaving of pure silk fabrics. KSIC uses high quality pure natural silk and pure gold and silver zari. The students interacted with the industry experts of various departments and observed the process to know in detail about the silk processing, weaving, dyeing and finishing.



This industrial visit which was organized to "Karnataka Silk Industries Corporation, Mysuru" was indeed very helpful for the students in understanding the textile pretreatments, weaving, dyeing, and finishing of silk yarns and fabric which is a part of their Textile Wet Processing Curriculum.

After the visit the students were taken for Mysore palace and Balmuri Falls. Students enjoyed the beauty of the palace and played in the water and enjoyed the coracle ride witnessing the scenery of Balmuri Falls.



























FIELD VISIT TO "SILK INDIA"

A Field visit was organised to Silk India-2024, a handloom & jewellery exhibition at Sindhoor Conventional Hall. Students of final year were taken for this field visit as this exhibition had rich collection of Indian Traditional Art & Craft, which is also the course for them in VI semester.

The exhibition had various traditional textiles from different states of India. Sambalpuri of Odisha, Bangalore silks of Karnataka, Tussar of Assam, Patola of Gujarat, Kashida of Jammu and Kashmir and other textiles from Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh, were also in display. Art forms like Madhubani, Pattachitra paintings ,metal jewellery were also on display. Students were benefitted a lot as they had an exposure to the Indian handloom textiles. They interacted with the artisans and weavers of various textiles and learnt a lot out of this visit.

It was a great practical exposure on various types of traditional weaves and other art forms of India. The Artisans briefed students on the making of their textiles, raw materials used etc.
