

MILESTONE JOURNEY OF NAAC 3rd CYCLE



Date of Visit: 16th and 17th April 2024 Date of Receipt of Grade: 25th April 2024

V E T First Grade College, in its glorious journey of 28 years of education, has undergone two cycles of accreditation with B and B+ grades and has prepared vigorously for the third cycle. The preparations started a year ago with the formation of various teams and allocation of work to all. The NAAC peer team members were received by Principal, Vice Principal, IQAC Coordinator and Alumni Students in the airport.

The team comprised Chairperson Dr

Priyamvada Srivastava from Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University Chhattisgarh, Member Coordinator Dr. Rakesh Ramteke from KBC North Maharashtra University and Member Dr Savita Joshi from Udaipur.

The NAAC peer team traditionally got a rousing welcome at VET First Grade College on Tuesday, April 16, 2024, when the team visited the institution to assess the performance of the institution for the 3rd cycle. The team was welcomed by the students with a traditional 'Aarati' and 'Poorna Kumbha' besides honored by the principal and administrators with a Mysore Peta, Shawl and Bouquet. The team after being greeted by NSS and Sports team was taken in procession by all till the Board room for presentation by the Principal.






Orientation programme on "Responsibility in Retail Operations and Management"






Virtual Workshop On Mobile App Development









TECHNO CLUB: THE COMPUTER SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY CLUB


